

## Vom Kaiserhofe's Certification for Narcotics Detection Canine Level One

There are three Levels of Certification, You Must Start with Level One:

:

To Meet Certification Standards all dogs must detect the following Odors:

Marijuana-Powder Cocaine-Crack Cocaine-Herion-Methamphetamine-Exctasy

If your Canine does not detect the above odors, than we must know what odors your canine works for Certification:

These odors will be tested in different environments:

Vehicles-Buildings-Luggage

Each Illegal Substance must be tested in Vehicles:

### Requirements

#### Vehicles:

There will be five Vehicle and two aids placed out, the canine team will Have 20 minutes to locate and alert to each aid. There will be an exterior and interior aid placed out. The canine team will not know where the aids are placed. The Handler must call all alerts. No aid will be more than 26 grams and no less than 5 grams.

One Vehicle will have a proof placed out either interior or exterior.

The proof can be of the Judges choice.

Food, Zip Lock Baggy, Ball, Urine, Feces, Duct Tape, Powder Aspirin.

The proof cannot interfere with the scent of the Aid.

This is a Pass or Fail Certification. The canine team has one retest per environment only, and must retest on the aid they fail on in the same environment.

They will be tested on four aids per environment, and the Judge must make sure the canine team tests on all 6 drugs by changing what is placed out in each environment.

Only real Narcotics can be used, no stimulants will be used. No other canine team will work the same area; each team will have their own area to work.

#### Buildings:

Seven Large rooms will be used for this test:

Two rooms will be blank with no aids will be placed out, One room will have proofs Placed out, Such as food, ball, zip lock baggy, Urine, feces, duct Tape, Powder Aspirin.

Which proof is placed out is the choice of the Judge.

Four rooms will have aids placed out for the canine team to locate and alert.

No aid will be larger than 26 grams and no less than 5 grams.

Canine team will have 25 minutes to find and locate and call alert to each aid placed out.

Heart Of America Police Dog Association and Vom Kaiserhofe's Training Center Narcotics Detection Canine Certification:

Which aid is placed out is also the choice of the Judge

This a Pass or Fail Certification:

A canine team will have one retest per environment:

Aids will sit for 45 minutes before the team sniffs its area of Test:Luggage-Parcels-Boxes:

Over 35 pieces of the above listed environment will be placed out for the canine team to work.

This can be done inside a building or outside on the ground.

Four aids will be placed out, one per piece of luggage, box, parcels.

There will be one proof placed out as well, and the proof cannot interfere with the aid.

Each piece of Luggage, box, and parcel shall be at least 10 feet apart.

No more than 40 grams and no less than 26 grams of each aid will be used.

Aids will be allowed to sit for 45 minutes before the team shall start the sniff of their area:

The canine team will have 20 minutes to sniff and call all alerts:

The proof is the choice of the Judge:

This is a pass or fail Certification:

The Handler must call all alerts:

A canine Team will have one retest per environment:

Rules:

All aids shall have a sit time of 45 minutes before any canine team starts to sniff environments:

Canine Handler must call all alerts:

Canine Handler will tell the Judge when he is ready to start the sniff:

Handlers can move anything around that they want, but they cannot open any lockers, drawers, luggage, and cabinets.

The Judge will tell the Handler when each 5 minutes of time has passed:

The Judge will not help:

The Judge must make sure the proper amounts of odor are hidden:

The Judge must make sure that no proofs interfere with the odor of an aid:

The Judge must make sure that there is scent available on all aids placed out:

The Judges decision stands:

The Judge and his or her helper will place each aid in its hidden place, and Document the same:

If a Canine Team Fails this test, they can retake this test the next day, if they fail one area only they can simply retake that area of environment, with same drugs.

The Canine Team must show the Judge that they can do on and Off Leash Obedience:

Left turns, right turns, turn about. Recall on command, down,

The Canine Team must also show they can complete the Obstacle Course:

Barrels, Plank walk, Window Jump, Six foot A Frame, Three foot Chain Link, And 39 Inch

Wooden Jump:

This test is worth 25 points to the Canine Team and they must show 17 Points to Pass:

This test can be also retaken the next day if the team would fail.
